The SPE Mid-Continent is pleased to announce the 21st Annual Sporting Clays Classic. This year the Classic will be held on the afternoon of Friday, October 21st at Longshot Ranch. Lunch will be served at 11:30 and shooting will begin at 1:00.

Entry fee will be \$200 per shooter or \$1000 per 5-man team. The golf carts will be an extra \$135. Please note: You must reserve the cart by October 7th. Payment options include Check or Credit Card through Eventbrite.

As always, the Classic will include 100 clay targets, lunch, drinks and lots of prizes. All participants will be scored individually and classed by a Lewis Class Scoring System. Shooters will be required to provide their own shotgun shells (2 ¾", #9, #8 or #7 ½ shot). Please bring extra shells in case of a malfunction. The wobble trap and 5-stand will be available for a minimal fee if you wish to practice while waiting for your starting time.

The door prize drawing will occur during your round and winners will be posted on the bulletin board.

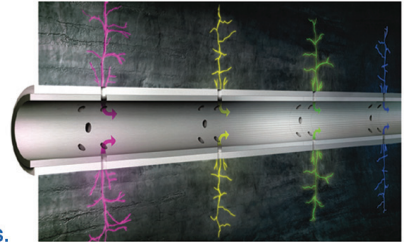


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2016 Fall Round-Up Golf Tournament
